

# Mexican Oregano

*Poliomintha longiflora*



A native evergreen, edible perennial with very aromatic foliage. Produces masses of tubular lavender flowers from late spring through fall. 3'x3' rounded shrub like appearance. Fragrant. Used in Mexican cooking as its flavor is quite distinct from the more common Italian oreganos. Full sun and good drainage. Hummingbird & butterfly attractor!
