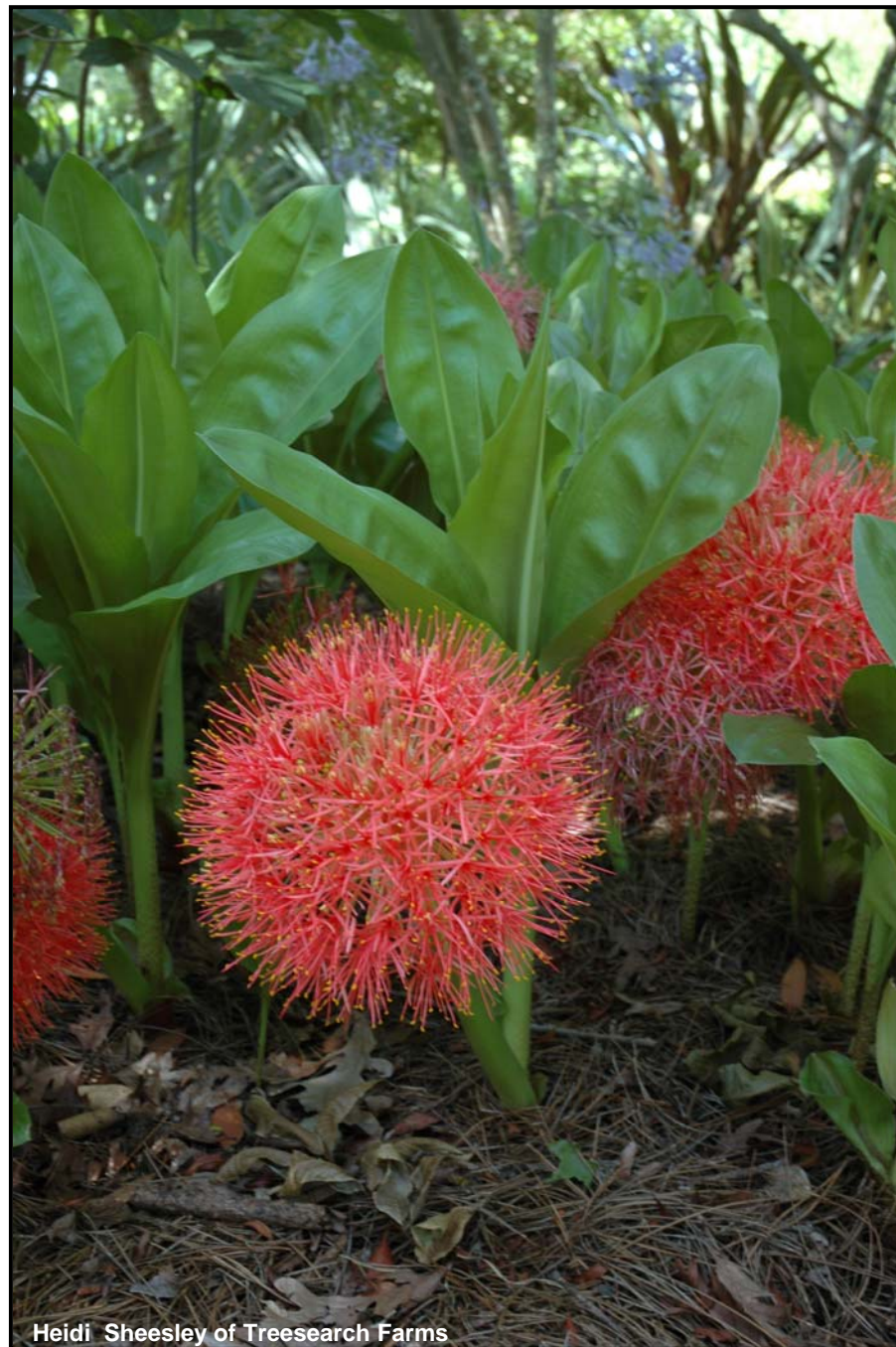


Blood Lily

Scadoxus multiflorus

A spectacular, naturalizing bulb from South Africa that puts on a stunning show of color in early summer. Exploding out of the ground on thick solitary stems are dazzling, 7"-8" globe-like flowerheads consisting of up to 200 brilliant red starry flowers followed by attractive, upright, dark green, glossy spear-shaped foliage. It thrives in shade gardens, is striking in large groups under trees, does beautifully in containers & as an indoor plant, & also makes an excellent cut flower. It needs a moist, well-drained soil. Known to be slightly toxic if eaten.
