Double Rangoon Creeper

Quisqualis hybrid(recently reclassified as Combretum indicum)



Large clusters of white tubular buds open to many petalled fragrant white flowers that change through pink, red, and deep maroon. The Double Rangoon Creeper is a highly sought after vigorous twining climber that flowers profusely throughout the growing summer. Provide this tropical climber with a full to mostly sunny position in a fertile well-drained soil for optimum results. The Rangoon Creepers are considered to be <u>root hardy</u> into zone 8 if given proper winter protection. The flowers attract hummingbird moths early in the day and bees and other pollinators once the flower color deepens.
