Five-Finger Maidenhair Fern Adiantum pedatum



12" long fan-like fronds divide into five branches on this **native** fern. Chestnut brown to purple-black stipes are usually one-half the length of its lustrous dark green fronds. Performs best in moist, rich, well-drained soil. An absolute highlight in the woodland garden. 12"-30", deciduous, spreading.
