

Cherokee Sedge

Carex cherokeensis



An incredibly versatile native Carex – works great in rain gardens, meadows, or as a lawn alternative, tall ground cover or filler. Arching green foliage with bunching habit. Semi-evergreen in mild climates. Spreads via short rhizomes and reseedling – so plant where more is welcome. Drooping seedheads form in spring. Occurs naturally in moist habitats but will tolerate drier conditions. 10"-12", sun to partial shade.
