

Native White Yarrow

Achillea millefolium



Also known as common yarrow – a rhizomatous, spreading, upright to mat forming perennial that can be used to “naturalize” areas and can even be used as a lawn substitute. Fern like aromatic foliage and white flowers in dense flattened groups appear June to September. Cut back plants to lateral flower buds after initial flowering to keep tidy and encourage more blooms. Full sun. Attracts many pollinators. Tolerates drought dry soil, air pollution and deer. Good cut flower. Foliage normally evergreen here.
