

White Woodland Painted Petals

Anomatheca laxa 'Alba'



1" white flowers on soft, grassy "iris-like" foliage, cover this plant late March into April. Goes dormant in the summer, reseeds, and returns from both seed and corms in the winter. Drought tolerant, partial shade, well drained soil. Nice cut flower – looks similar to freesia, but is adapted to our Houston climate.
