American Beautyberry

Callicarpa americana





One of the finest native, deciduous shrubs for summer, fall and winter interest. Clusters of <u>dark purple berries</u> begin forming on arching stems in late summer. Berry color can vary from dark plum, to pink to rosy-purple. Showiest after the leaves drop in late fall. Understory conditions are where it is happiest – partial sun/shade. Averages 5'-6' – best to prune hard in early spring. **Birds love beautyberry**! Tolerant of harsh conditions.
