Small clusters of 1" medium yellow lily-like flowers are born on tall slender 3' spikes above low growing light green rosettes of strap-like foliage. A rare Texas native that is heat and cold tolerant. Clump forming, tough perennial for well-drained soils. 12"-18"h x 2'w foliage, flower spikes taller. Full sun to part sun.
