Native Purple Coneflower 'T.J.'s'



Blooming spring to fall, purple coneflower is an outstanding perennial, cut flower, **butterfly** attractor & overall fantastic plant for the garden during our hot summers. The flower stalks can reach 1'- 2' tall. Coneflowers like sun to light shade, and good drainage. Their golden-brown seedheads remain on the flower stalk long after the petals fade and provide food for birds. **This particular selection is grown exclusively at Treesearch Farms** from seed originally collected by plantsman T. J. Marks, who then provided the seed to "plant people" Mike & Patsy Anderson. They provide us with the pure seed each year. This variety is more of hot pink color, & grows a bit shorter than the regular, paler purple native coneflower. It is also quite prolific in the garden, returning each year a stronger, more vigorous plant which will reseed and fill your garden with color.
