

‘Spindrift’ Erigeron

Erigeron karvinskianus ‘Spindrift’



‘Spindrift’ is a low dwarf selection of erigeron that forms a dome of feathery foliage smothered with a continuous flower display spring to frost. The dainty daisy-like flowers emerge white and age to rose-pink and dusky pink. All colors are displayed at once for a charming effect. Pollinators will appreciate the long bloom time. Full to part sun with well-drained soil. Excellent for Xeric low water gardens but appreciates an occasional deep soaking in summer. Try it to soften and edge paths, tucked in a wall crevice or a rock garden & between stepping stones. Deer and rabbit resistant. Ht. 8” x W 12” Semi-evergreen perennial. Zones 6-9. Tolerates root competition.
