

# Sandi-leaf Fig Ivy

*Ficus tikoua*



Not the classic fig ivy – this one is a tough, bold, coarsely textured ground cover for sun or part shade. Medium green, 3”-5” oval shaped leaves have a sandpaper texture. Self-layering, carpets an area fairly rapidly. Produces small figlets that birds might enjoy. Normally evergreen in Houston –in extended hard freezes, it has proven to be root hardy.
