

White Butterfly Ginger

Hedychium coronarium

The most fragrant of them all!
Clusters of fragrant white flowers
resemble butterflies atop 6'
stems. Makes a wonderful cut
flower. Can freeze to the ground
but will return in late spring.
Grows well in containers, & at the
margins of ponds. Bright shade
to full sun if well watered. Keep
bloom stalks cut to the ground
after the flowers fade to
encourage more blooms.
