Sorghastrum nutans



Also known as Yellow Indian Grass, *Sorghastrum nutans* is a tall native grass that provides excellent habitat and nesting sites for pollinators. Its seeds are a valuable food source for birds. It has long been considered one of the most beautiful of all the native grasses. Foliage grows in a mounding 2' arching shape. 6' culms emerge late summer topped with feathery plumes which hold intricate flower structures. Drought-tolerant. A major grass of the North American prairie.
