

Chives



Chives can grow well in sun to partial shade. Plant in early spring in soil amended with plenty of good compost. They are tough enough to withstand poor soil, but won't grow as fast. They need little care other than watering. The plants produce more leaves if you pinch off the flower buds. Cut often to keep new leaves coming. Usually evergreen here. After 3 or 4 years, you can divide the clump and replant.
