

Red Yucca

Hesperaloe parviflora



A stemless and thornless succulent with clumps of arching and spreading grass like foliage that has deep grooves and white fraying fibers along the margins.

Clumps spread slowly up to 6' wide. In late spring through summer, the clusters of rose-pink flowers are borne on tall red stalks to 5' long. Full sun or light shade, well-drained soil. Drought tolerant – appreciates occasional water in the summer if there's been no rain to encourage flowering; but, don't over water it. Hardy to well below 0. Good cut flower. **Hummingbirds**. A low maintenance gardener's dream come true!
