Red Yucca

Hesperaloe parviflora



Clumps spread slowly up to 6' wide. In late spring through summer, the clusters of <u>rose-pink flowers</u> are borne on tall red stalks to 5' long. Full sun or light shade, well-drained soil. Drought tolerant – appreciates occasional water in the summer if there's been no rain to encourage flowering; but, don't over water it. Hardy to well below 0. Good cut flower. **Hummingbirds.** A low maintenance gardener's dream come true!
