Oakleaf fall color – wow!



A native shade loving shrub with spectacular large foliage and lovely creamy-white flowers in spring. Striking red-orange fall foliage color. Deciduous. Needs moist, well drained soil, but is much more tolerant of heat and dry conditions than a “mophead” hydrangea. Grows 6’-8’. Prefers some morning sun and afternoon shade. Nice cut flower.
