A native shade loving shrub with spectacular large foliage

and lovely panicles of <u>creamy-white flowers</u> in spring. Striking <u>red-orange</u> fall foliage color. Deciduous. Needs moist, well drained soil, but is much more tolerant of heat and dry conditions than a "mophead" hydrangea. Grows 6'-8'. Prefers some morning sun and afternoon shade. Nice cut flower.
