

# Mexican River Spider Lily

*Hymenocallis acutiflora* v. *riparia*



*Hymenocallis riparia* comes from southwest Mexico, where it grows along streams. Easy to grow – it prefers wet soil, but will also grow successfully in typical garden soils. The 2' wide clumps of narrow green strap leaves are topped in June with 18" spikes of white flowers. Perennial. Grows in shade or sun – as long as it is well watered.
