

SNOWFLAKE

Leucojum aestivum



This heirloom bulb thrives in the South. The tiny, pure-white bell shaped blooms have a subtle, sweet fragrance and appear in drooping clusters of two to six in late January or early February. The six snowy petals are marked with unique thickened green spots at the tips. Plant “en masse” for the best display. Slowly colonizes. Leucojum is a MUST for every garden.
