

Rough Blazingstar

Liatris aspera



This liatris is perfect for medium to dry, well-drained soils. Usually reaches 2'-3' – shorter than many Blazingstars. Tufted lavender blooms cover the flower stalks in late summer and attract butterflies, hummingbirds and bees. “Aspera” is latin for rough which refers to the short stiff hairs on the stem and leaves. The stems are slightly zigzagged as well. Perennial. Native. Full sun.
