Red Giant Turk's Cap

Malvaviscus arboreus



This native perennial shrub of Mexico & Texas makes a spectacular fall statement in any garden with its showy display of large partially opened, vivid red flowers. It's an absolute magnet for Hummingbirds, & many bird species enjoy dining on the attractive red fruit. Giant Turk's Cap forms a large 5'-6' shrub or can be trained into a 6'-8' tree form. It is an extremely tough & versatile plant & will grow in sun or part shade. It's drought tolerant, yet will tolerate wet, & will perform in a wide variety of soils. Goes dormant in winter & is root hardy into Zone 8.
