If you google **Moringa Tree**, you will find <u>so much information it can be overwhelming</u>. But **google it you must**, because there is too much to write about this <u>edible</u> here. It is native to India, grows extremely fast, blooms profusely in the summer, (bees are all over it!), and produces long "bean pods" at the end of the season. It is tropical, so either be prepared to protect from freezes – or, collect the bean pods and replant for next season. It will bloom and produce again each year. Plant in sun to part sun.
