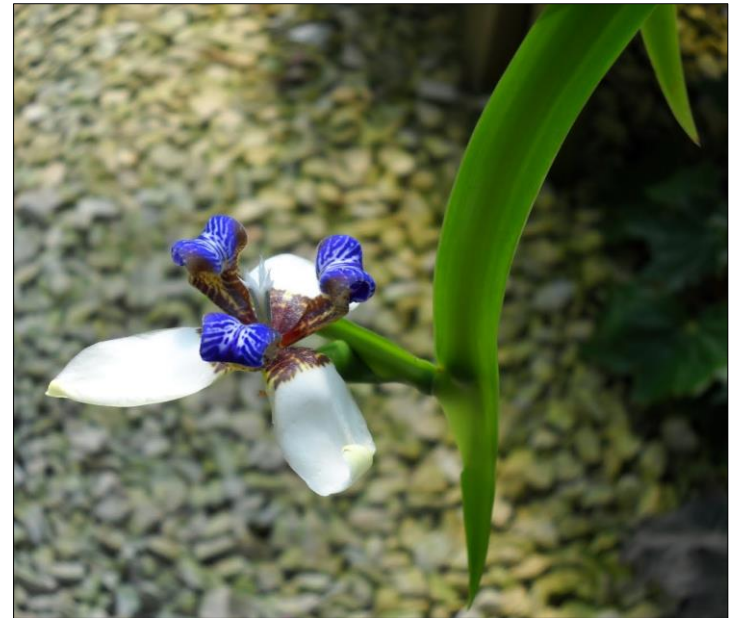


# Walking Iris

## *Neomarica gracilis*



Striking, sword-like glossy green foliage makes this iris a standout in the garden. A lovely vertical accent for shade. Produces 2" white & blue flowers in the spring. Foliage grows 18"-24" tall. As the flowers age, small plant pups are formed which weigh down the leaves so they touch the ground and root – forming another plant. Thus its name, "Walking Iris". They go dormant in the winter. Needs moist, well-drained soil and light shade or morning sun.
