This is the first citrus grown in Texas around the Santa Fe area, dating back to 1847. Considered the most cold hardy of all oranges. The fruit is very sweet, juicy, highly flavorful and slightly seedy. It's also a very heavy producer. Mature size averages 15' x 15' if not pruned.
