## Mountain Pea Orbexilum pedunculatum



Here is a unique, groundcover that is <u>native</u> to the southwestern U.S. It forms a dense mat of <u>glossy green</u> leaves that spread by short rhizomes –it would be good for stabilizing a sunny slope. The <u>bluish-purple flower spikes</u> occur May through July. The seeds are a nutritious treat for several species of birds. <u>EVERGREEN!</u>
