





An extraordinary accent plant for the landscape!

This unique succulent has mostly leafless, lime green stems that stand straight up when planted in sun & arched & wavy when planted in shade. It forms a clump of stems about 3'-4' tall by 3' wide & produces unusual orange-red slipper-shaped (or dragon-head) flowers along the stems in spring & fall. It's extremely drought tolerant & needs good drainage. Hummingbirds!

The far reaching uses for this fascinating plant are limited by one's imagination; in containers, interior designs, courtyards, under light airy trees such as <u>Retamas</u>, or as a living fence, etc.
