Pigeonberry is one of our favorite **native** ground covers. It can be covered in pink and white flowers and red berries, all at the same time. That happens about



7 months out of the year in Houston. It likes to be tucked up under a larger shrub, or a good shade tree. Pigeonberry likes moisture, so plan on occasional watering for best results. **Birds love the red fruits**! Evergreen in warm climates, dormant in cold winters. Foliage turn burgundy in the winter. Partial sun to shade.
