Japanese Sacred Lily Rohdea japonica



Rohdea or Sacred Lily is a fantastic yet still little known plant from Japan that has a number of great attributes for the garden. It produces <u>dark green</u> strap-shaped leaves up to 18" long and 3" wide. The highly ornamental red fruits color up in the fall and persist through the winter at the base of the plant. **Evergreen** – even in the harshest winters. Grows in deep shade or light shade. Makes an excellent container plant for small spaces. Slow grower – not particular as to soil moisture. **Deer resistant**.
