

Trilobed Rudbeckia
Rudbeckia triloba



Masses of 1" <u>yellow daisies with brown centers</u> make this prairie native a standout in any garden. Basal leaves are divided into 3 parts. Flowers form at the ends of many-branched stems with narrow leaves so the plants are completely covered as it blooms in cycles from spring thru fall. Best in full sun or light shade. Drought tolerant once established.
