Edible? Check! **Fragrant?** Check! **Perennial?** Check! **Hummingbird magnet?** Check! Pineapple sage has it all & then some. What a great addition to any garden – thrives in Houston’s hot, humid climate. Grows 3’x3’ – you can prune often to maintain a fuller, lusher plant. Blooms **bright red tubular flowers** off and on summer through first frost. Foliage smells like pineapple and is used in cooking – does well as a cut flower too. Plant in sun to partial sun – seems to do best with some afternoon shade.
