

Sinningia sellovii Hardy Red Gloxinia This fascinating, wonderfully textured hardy gloxinia forms a 20" clump composed of thick green sandpaper-like leaves on slightly arching stems. From late spring to fall 30" spikes of <u>pendant scarlet-orange 1" bell-shaped flowers</u> emerge from the tips of the stems. This hardy perennial grows in full sun or light shade & does beautifully whether in rock gardens, perennial borders, or as a specimen container plant. Needs

moist but well drained soil. Goes dormant in winter & flushes out in mid spring into a full gorgeous plant!
