Mexican mint marigold has so much to offer – this **edible**, perennial herb thrives in hot, humid weather when other herbs have pooped out. Clusters of **bright yellow flowers** appear every fall and continue into winter – a great cut flower for fall arrangements. Upright growth 2'-3'. “Texas tarragon” has the **fragrance** and **flavor** of French tarragon and can be used in the same manner. Prefers full sun, good drainage. **Butterflies!**
