

Walter's Viburnum

Viburnum obovatum

An outstanding, native, <u>evergreen</u> large shrub or small tree with attractive small dark green leaves. Produces a magnificent display of <u>clusters of white flowers</u> in February-March. Tough, easy to grow, & very versatile. Can be used as a hedge, screen, or small "tree". Un-pruned, it forms a very large, full, evenly shaped shrub, but pruned as a hedge (from 3' tall to 12' tall) it becomes an incredibly thick, impenetrable wall of green. Tolerates drought & the occasional flood, tolerates a wide range of soils, & grows in sun or part shade. Can be trained as a small 12' x 10' ornamental "tree". Grows from 6'-12' tall.
