Matchstick Bromeliad

Aechmea gamosepala





This winter blooming bromeliad comes from Brazil. Its blooms are thick bristles of purplish-pink bracts tipped with <u>iridescent blue bead-like flowers</u>. After flowering, the spike turns <u>dark pink</u> & holds for weeks. It will grow in shady corners or even places where there is hardly any soil. It can form an attractive, low-maintenance groundcover as it <u>multiplies very well</u>. Tolerates mild frosts beautifully! Being epiphytic, it can also be grown in the fork of a tree. This is one tough bromeliad.
