

We are Visiting Danbury Library!



Our class is going to Danbury Library! Your child will learn about the library and hear a story read by library staff. Ahead of the visit, you can apply for your child's library card so you're ready to borrow books right away from Danbury Library.

Danbury Library is located at **170 Main Street**, (not at your child's school) and is a fantastic free resource for borrowing books and movies, attending events and programming for all ages, and so much more.

If your family already has library cards, you do not need to reapply. Danbury Library cards are active for two years at a time and you keep the same card for as long as you live in Danbury. Each time they expire the library will confirm you're still living in Danbury and renew your card for another two years.

If you need a new card for your child, or would like us to renew an existing one, please complete the application on the back of this sheet. If you have any questions about your library card account, you can call the library at 203-797-4505.

Please return the application to your child's teacher.

Library cards will be delivered to your child on the day of the class visit and come home in their backpack.
