Quarantine Requirements for All Employees Effective August 10, 2021 (Update to Quarantine Requirements issued on April 22, 2021)

The City of Danbury requires all employees to wear a mask when indoors regardless of vaccination status

All City of Danbury Employees are required to self-monitor for symptoms of COVID-19 and stay home if symptomatic

1. Non-Vaccinated Employees:

No changes to the Quarantine Requirements dated April 22, 2021 including the travel requirements

2. Fully Vaccinated Employees

Although the risk that fully vaccinated employees could become infected with COVID-19 is low, any fully vaccinated person who **is symptomatic** must:

- Self-Isolate from others (Do NOT report to work)
- Wear a mask
- Get tested for COVID-19
 - **If positive for COVID-19**, employee must quarantine for 10 days

Fully vaccinated employees who are exposed* to COVID-19 and are **NOT** symptomatic must:

- Wear a mask (Employee may continue to work wearing a mask at all times while on duty)
- Get tested 3-5 days following the date of the exposure
 - **If positive for COVID-19**, employee must quarantine for 10 days

Domestic Travel

Vaccinated Employees must monitor for symptoms upon return from travel

International Travel

Vaccinated Employees must:

- Receive a COVID-19 Test prior to returning to the United States
- Receive a COVID-19 Test 3-5 days after travel

- Self-Quarantine after travel for 7 days with a negative test and 10 days without testing or positive for COVID-19
- Self-Monitor for symptoms
- Wear a mask during travel

Departments must continue to enforce:

- Mandatory Mask Wearing
- Social distancing (no breaks/lunch at the same table, workout rooms, etc). If a 6-foot distance cannot be maintained due to job requirements, masks must be worn and distanced must be maintained as much as practicable.

*Exposure:

- An individual who has been in direct contact (within 6 feet with or without a mask for at least 15 cumulative minutes over a 24-hour time period) with a Covid-19 positive person during their infectious period.
 - Asymptomatic Covid-19 positive individuals are infectious to others **48 hours before** they **test** positive, until **10 days after** their positive test date.
 - Symptomatic Covid-19 positive individuals are infectious to others **48 hours before** their **symptoms** began, until **10 days after** their symptom onset.
