

# SBBA Meeting Minutes from June 3, 2021

#### **OLD BUSINESS:**

#### **Short Term Rentals:**

- Currently the changes City Council is discussing do not apply to Sandbridge, but we need confirmation of this and we agreed to keep an eye on this issue
- Safety ordinances could apply to Sandbridge, decks and fire extinguishers

## **Crossing Stations:**

- Flag poles were removed for paving project, but they have all been reinstalled
- Need for 5 more flag stations
- We discussed a way to identify the flag stations as compliments of the SBBA, maybe stickers, cost?

### **Community Party:**

- Discussion of whether we should have this event the day after Pig Pickin or during the summer
- Pat Barton did some work on this event last year before it was canceled
- Kathie Springer has notes on the event held in 2019

#### **NEW BUSINESS:**

## Meeting with Captain Gandy was held on May 27:

- With the new auto pay system the city believes that they will be able to have increased manpower to better handle parking violations this year
- Golf Carts:
  - Golf carts are NOT allowed in Sandbridge
  - Golf carts are only allowed in communities that have permission from City Council to operate (ie: Lagomar & Chics Beach)
  - Street legal low speed vehicles are allowed on roads up to and including 35 miles an hour
  - Street legal low speed vehicles are allowed on all roads in Sandbridge
- Captain Gandy is leaving Virginia Beach for Alabama, a suggestion was made to have a meet & greet with his replacement before he leaves

## **Upcoming Sandbridge Events:**

- SBCL meeting to announce scholarships including SBBA scholarship is scheduled for June 21<sup>st</sup>
- Party at the Pier will be held August 27<sup>th</sup>
- Pig Pickin:
  - Pig Pickin is set for September 11<sup>th</sup>

  - Kathie S will start working on the SBBA poster
