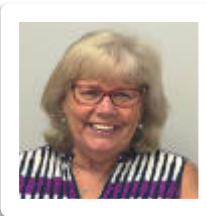

WPSC Chat Bridge

Chat Bridge is a duplicate bridge training program in which four players new to the game sit at a table to bid and play pre-selected bridge hands from the ACBL Common Game under the direction of a Chat Leader who is a highly experienced bridge player. Chat Bridge can be conducted in either a face-to-face or a virtual environment. Students are encouraged to “chat” by asking questions and interacting with their table partner, opponents, and Chat Leader while they play the hand.

Evolution of Chat Bridge at WPSC

The idea for Chat Bridge was brought to the WPSC bridge club from the Rochester, MN bridge club three years ago by Dave Hoffman who currently chairs the WPSC Bridge Education Committee. Dave asked Linda James to set up and manage weekly face-to-face Chat Bridge instruction sessions at WPSC. Participation rose from 2 tables weekly to as many as 6 tables weekly under Linda’s leadership. When the pandemic began to surge in March of 2020, WPSC shut down all activities where people gathered in close proximity, including bridge. However, by July, Chat was re-started, but this time virtually by connecting Chat Leaders and their students via Zoom and Bridge Base On-Line (BBO). So, Chat Bridge continues on a weekly basis today by loading pre-selected hands from the ACBL Common Game into the BBO data base, Chat Leaders connecting with their students through Zoom and assigning those students to their virtual BBO seats at the table. Leaders and their students thus have interactive video and audio—really no different than all of them being face-to-face. We now have seven Chat Bridge instructors teaching 30 students. Additionally, WPSC Chat Bridge has expanded to include several players who reside in other states and Canada. For now, WPSC Chat Bridge

is solely a virtual event and is likely to stay that way for the foreseeable future.

Management of WPSC Chat Bridge

WPSC Chat Bridge is currently managed by WPSC members, Dave Seares and Celia Phillips. All Chat Leaders are volunteers. Chat student dues are \$10 per month. Approximately \$1,000 per year from the dues collected pay an annual fee for Chat leader Zoom licenses, whereas the rest of the money collected is given to the WPSC Treasurer, \$2600 per year based on the current number of students. Celia maintains the Chat roster while Dave tracks student payments. Below are the Chat Bridge Leaders (Instructors):

Those of us who teach Chat Bridge believe that both beginning and intermediate players can benefit from joining. Dave and Celia attempt to assign players with similar abilities to the same Chat group. All of the Chat leaders are at least Gold Life Masters, with one leader a Diamond Life Master and another leader an Emerald Life Master. 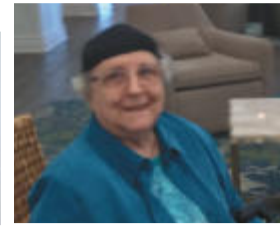

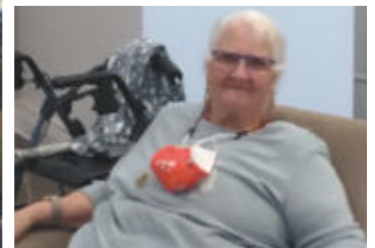

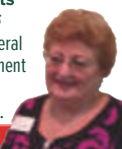
