#### **BETTER & STRONGER IN 2025!**

Do you have difficulty walking, climbing stairs, or getting up from a chair? Welcome to a type of training that reduces body fat, reduces frailty, Increases muscle mass and decreases your risk of injury. Strength training not only makes you stronger it improves your ability to perform day to day activities. Carrying groceries, gardening, and lifting suitcases as well as grandkids becomes a bit easier.



An important benefit of weight training is preserving and improving bone density, decreasing muscle loss and preventing falls. This type of exercise has shown to be effective for treating depression and stress.

In the Bones and Balance class we incorporate functional strength which is tailored to older adults. In order to keep moving longer I incorporate movements that include: pushing, pulling, squatting, lunging, rotating, and carrying.

There is no age limit for getting stronger! Start low (resistance) and go slow. Move however your joints and muscles allow. As your strength improves you can add more resistance to continue building muscle strength. Progressive overloading your muscles is crucial for longevity and living independently.

We use exe-tubing, bands, hand weights and tennis balls in class. Every muscle group is challenged. Large muscles are worked first, then smaller muscle groups, ending with a cool down stretch. All equipment is provided; however you are welcome to bring your own. Each exercise will be explained and demonstrated.

No pain allowed! Activating our core muscles will take the focus away from stressing our joints. A few side benefits of class are an increase in your social capital, better cognitive function, and just plain fun!

Remember the saying; If you always do what you always did you always get what you always got.
