

Mitch Paperdoll

Print your paperdoll.

A. This will work better on a heavier paper or glue the paper to a piece of cardstock or construction paper before you cut them out.

Color your paperdoll. You don't HAVE to use black and white.

Cut out the pieces of the doll. Make sure to cut or punch the circles on the tabs.

Roll a short length of paper.

A. It will need to fit through the holes in the tabs. You can use a piece of straw, but it will be harder to glue.

glue the roll to the back of the face piece. It should be about where the nose is.

Slide the other pieces on.

A. The gripping piece can be anywhere.

B. The shirt piece must go on before the pants.

Glue a smal piece of paper to the other end of the roll to keep all the pieces together.

Once everything dries, your paperdoll can hang out with you.
