

\Multiplication Quick Rules for 9

- your hands can help! Example: to multiply 9 by 8, hold your 8th finger down, and count "7" and "2", the answer is **72**



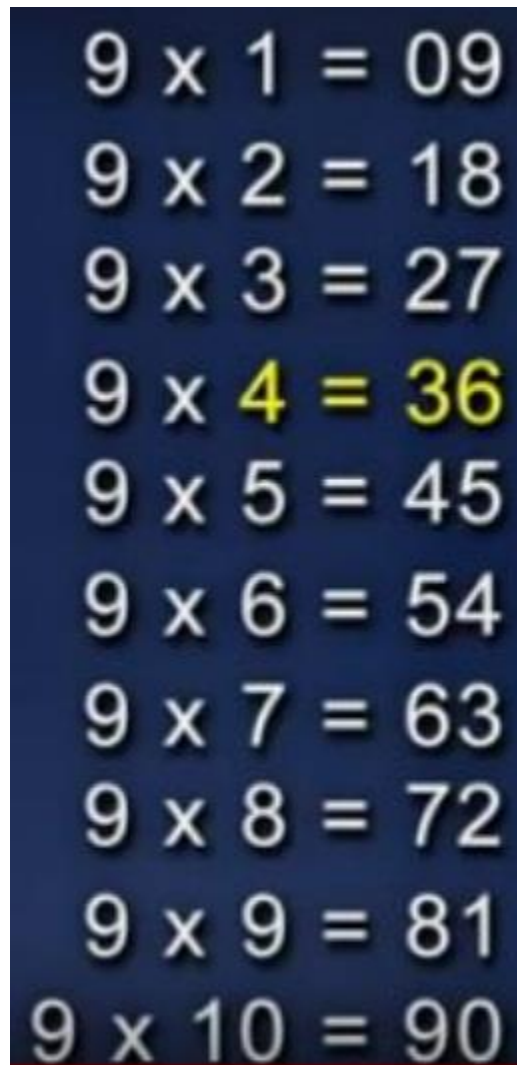
The two digits in the answer need to add up to 9

$9 \times 1 = 09$
$9 \times 2 = 18$
$9 \times 3 = 27$
$9 \times 4 = 36$
$9 \times 5 = 45$
$9 \times 6 = 54$
$9 \times 7 = 63$
$9 \times 8 = 72$
$9 \times 9 = 81$
$9 \times 10 = 90$

	$0 + 9 = 9$
	$1 + 8 = 9$
	$2 + 7 = 9$
Check	$3 + 6 = 9$
Your	$4 + 5 = 9$
Work	$5 + 4 = 9$
	$6 + 3 = 9$
	$7 + 2 = 9$
	$8 + 1 = 9$
	$9 + 0 = 9$

The answer always starts with a number that is one less than the multiplicand

Since we know the two numbers need to add up to 9 we can use subtraction to get the answer



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
