Part 2: Defining Intelligence



What is Intelligence?



Intelligence is the ability to receive, store and synthesise energetic information, for the purpose of sustaining existence.



True intelligence is always generative.



Intelligence depends on neurophysiological mechanisms of sensory perception to dynamically receive energetic information.

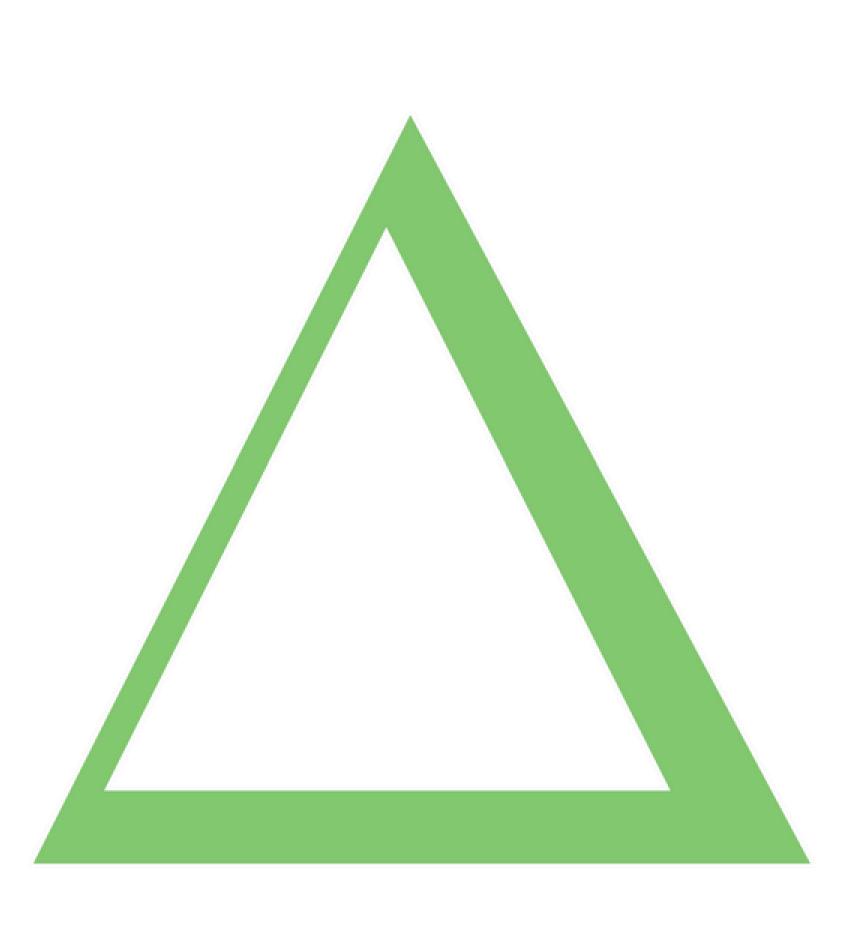
