The 2025 competition will be held at the Prairie Meadows Parking Lot, Des Moines IA.. Fields set up on Thursday August 28th, 2025, starting at 8:00 AM. All members are encouraged to come out and assist with the field set-up and get a layout of the facilities.

Our Captains meeting will be held at 3:30 PM the same day at the above room. All Competition times and information on Competition and Parking will be given at this meeting. Awards Banquet tickets will be available prior to and after the meeting.

The Awards Banquet will be held on Friday, August 29th, at the Airport Holiday Inn & Conference Center, 6111 Fleur Dr. Des Moines, IA in the Main Banquet Hall. We will have a social hour with a cash bar starting at 6:00 PM and dinner will be served at 7:00 PM, awards will follow dinner. The cost is \$50.00 per person. We will be serving a plated meal with Roast Beef (Slow Cooked with Garlic Red Wine Reduction), Green Beans with Bacon and Onions, Cheesy Au gratin Potatoes and Dinner Rolls with butter.

2025 COMMENTS AND REMINDERS

COMPETITIVE DRILL: Motor vehicles are to be inspected prior to Competitive Drill as they are to be operated during the drill. No miscellaneous items are to be added or removed between inspection and riding the drill.

A stop line will be painted 20' past the exit gate on each Competitive Drill Field. The lead member of each Unit must come to a complete stop before crossing the line at completion of routine. Any Unit not coming to a complete stop will be disqualified.

Field A and B proposed size: 120' x 240'

Discussion was held on the clarification for flag vehicles and the following was determined: A flag vehicle will be allowed in Competitive Drill. The flag vehicle will enter the drill field and come to a complete stop in a position on the field so as not to interfere with the drill. The flag vehicle shall remain in this position until the drill is complete, then exit the field. Only one flag vehicle will be allowed per unit. If a vehicle becomes disabled on the Competitive Drill Field, the driver must move the vehicle to a safe location on the field so as not to interfere with the remainder of the drill or stay seated in the vehicle.

SHOW CAR/SHOW BIKE In the past, occasionally a judge would score an item that was not on the score sheet. After a Unit has completed their inspection, the sheets will be collected, and a committee will review them to make sure that a judge did not add any additional items that are not on the sheet. If they find any additional deductions that are not allowed, they will make that correction and bring this item to the judge's attention.

Drone Competition: Our new drone competition is inside this year for those interested in this type of motorized vehicle, remote-controlled cars and trucks will be considered in a future date. COMPETITION REGISTRATION: In the past there have been Units that have waited until after the competition registration deadline to register for the competition. No Unit will be penalized for any point deductions for late registration but will be charged a \$25.00 registration fee for each competition entered. The fee must be paid prior to any time assigned to the Unit.

Rule # 11 of the Obstacle Course has been modified. The rule previously stated that there will be a "safety stop line" placed 36" after the stop line in which the rider must stop the front wheel of his vehicle or be disqualified. The 36" designation was removed, and a stop line will still exist. The rider must come to a complete stop before crossing the line or be disqualified.
