The Antiracist Coalition at Trinity is sponsoring a book study of *Jesus and the Disinherited* by Howard Thurman. Join us on Sundays at 8am on Zoom using the Prayer and Communion Link. We will meet March 8, March 22, April 12, and April 26. *Jesus and the Disinherited* tells the story of Jesus as an impoverished, heavily persecuted Jew who was poor, disinherited, and dispossessed. Religious leader Howard Thurman contends that Jesus has always been a partner to the oppressed, even linking his struggles to the enduring discrimination and violence Black Americans experience. Originally published in 1949, the book offers a timeless testimony of faith that demonstrates how to thrive and flourish in a world that attempts to destroy one's humanity from the inside out.
