

## The Big Ask: What can you do this month for POLYFIX?

- 1. **Pre-op MJOA** Teams, please let us know when you recruit patients and their planned operative date is so that we can get in touch to complete the blinded central assessments of mJOA.
- 2. **MoveMed** Teams, please let us know if participants have agreed to participate using the MoveMed app, so that our central study team can get in touch with them and set them up. You can find MoveMed info sheet attached. The information we will need from them is available on the PID form, so we can easily set them up once you confirm their agreement to participate. All the information and set up will be followed by the central team.
