

THE LAST QUARTER

It's been quite an odd time for me in the last year. I of course have remained very busy, too busy to make time to publish a Spring and Summer newsletter, as you may have noticed. So, onto the last quarter. I certainly have noticed less jobs being registered this year than previous years, and July to Sept 2024 was no different. ISG collapsed and 30+ Planners coming into the market, having a knock-on effect for me. Sept. was quiet as some companies tried to source Planners directly where they could from the ISG fallout.

I registered less jobs in the last three months (22) than in the same period 1 year (41) and 2 years (29) ago. I do not read too much into this, as I had so many jobs to work on, I was not actively seeking new job registrations for much of this period. However, July 2024 was super successful securing a great many Planners jobs, taking my time away from generating new job vacancies.


In terms of what's been happening in the world of Construction & Infrastructure Planning. From my perspective things remain good, demand is good & I have had & continue to have an abundance of great jobs vacancies, fluctuating between 25-30 live job vacancies at any one time.

In the 3rd quarter of 2023, I registered 22 new job vacancies, compared to 25 new job vacancies the quarter before, & down from 41 from the same period last year (2023). As I said previously, I had to reduce my marketing at some stages over the last year, due to being overwhelmed with work at times. I also took a 10-day holiday break in this quarter, so you can see that demand really is good. It's a great time to be a Planner as I often say.

I continue to work on jobs vacancies located all over the UK, Ireland & mainland Europe & fingers crossed demand will continue to be strong. Whatever happens, like always I will get

my head down & continue to work hard every day, helping as many employers & Planners/ Project Controllers as I can.

I continue to see a lot of demand for experienced Planners for Data Centre construction projects, located on mainland Europe, but expect demand to increase in the UK in the years ahead. Contract jobs are scarce, and most jobs are still predominantly being deemed by the employer to be inside IR35. Many companies are not conducting a CEST assessment at all, it's more a case of their policy being that all contracts will be deemed inside IR35 regardless. Very frustrating.

The demand for Planners to be based full-time on projects in mainland Europe continues to grow as I continue to expand my client base. Having an EU passport or valid visa for the country is key due to Brexit.

I am looking forward to a busy Autumn 2024 and into 2025.
