

THE LAST QUARTER

Autumn is here, there is a chill in the air and there is less daylight as it seems dark as we go to work, and come home from work.

However, it's not all doom and gloom. In my opinion it's a great time to be a Planner. I for one have never had so many jobs for Planners during my 20 years of solely specialising in sourcing Planners form companies.

Demand for Planners is strong & I have been working on jobs all over the UK and Europe. I believe that demand will continue to be strong for the rest of 2021 and into 2022, fingers crossed.

It is great to see that many companies are very busy, some of those well run companies are the busiest that they have ever been and long may that continue. Many companies are now expecting workers to be back in the office or back onto sites, however most employers are more flexible than pre-Covid-19, and see homeworking (within reason) here to stay.

90% of the time interviews are still currently being done by video call, I've only had a few people called in for an office based face-to-face interview in the last quarter & that is more likely for 2nd or final interviews.

Employers are being more flexible when hiring, often stating that 1-3 days a week can be home based, as long as productivity is as good, however this is not a given. That is something good to come from the last 12 months.

Employers & employees ability to work from home & hopefully get a better work life balance. Long may this continue. In a survey I did this quarter I asked: "When thinking about a job move, what's most important to you?", which you can read here: bit.ly/2ZHEQQk 51% of votes highlighted that a work/ life balance was most important.

Demand for Planners & Project Controllers. I continue to have more & more openings for Planners on mainland Europe, where having an EU passport or valid visa for the country is key, as is the willingness to live near projects & speak the local language.



THE LAST QUARTER

Job registrations for the period July to Sept 2021 are down 3% from 35 jobs the previous quarter to 34 jobs; however job registrations are up 79% from the same period a year ago when only 19 jobs were registered.

There is still lots of demand & interest from employers seeking Planners that have a site management, site engineer or civil engineer background prior to moving into Planning.

Demand for freelance or contracted workers is still low. I do not see this changing from my perspective over the next few quarters, but we'll see. Only time will tell as they say.

Looking forwards, I see it continuing to remain busy for 2021 & into 2022.
