

THE LAST QUARTER

What a crazy 3 months since the last newsletter. I, probably like you, am just looking for stability in the world around us. The UK government seems to be in constant disarray & the UK media love bad news & I feel seem to stir things up for the worse. Could the world media actually exist just focusing on positive news? I doubt it.

Personally, I was happy with the UK mini budget, then a few weeks later all ripped up & the UK Prime Minister resigns (again). Let's hope things in the UK & around the globe will start to settle soon.

In terms of the sphere of Construction & Infrastructure Planning, things are good, demand is high & I have had & continue to have an abundance of great jobs vacancies, fluctuating between 30-45 live job vacancies in the period from July to Sept 2022.

I have been so busy that for a few weeks I chose not do any marketing to employers, as I did not want to take on any more work & owed it to those companies that I was working with to maximise my time trying to help them.

The last 3 months I was particularly busy sourcing Construction Planners, rather than


infrastructure Planners. I do not think demand is any less for Infrastructure/ Civils Planners, but I just had lots on in Construction and that leads to more of the same work.

In the 3rd quarter of 2022, I have registered 29 new job vacancies, (2.2 a week), compared to 42 (3.2 a week) new job vacancies the quarter before, & down from 34 from the same period last year (2021). I am not convinced that there is any trend to take from these figures, as I took a two-week holiday in this period, & two weeks not marketing to employers, so I believe this influenced the lower jobs vacancies registered for the period.

I continue to work on jobs vacancies located all over the UK, Ireland & mainland Europe & fingers crossed demand will continue to be strong, however, in the crazy world that now we seem to be living in these last 2-3 years, who knows. Oct to Dec historically for me has seen an uplift in the jobs registered compared to the quarter before. Whatever happens, like always I will get my head down & continue to work hard every day, helping as many employers & Planners/ Project Controllers as I can.

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Job registrations for the period July to Oct 2022 are down 31% from 43 jobs the previous quarter to 29 jobs & job registrations are down 15% from the same period a year ago when 34 jobs were registered.

Current trends:

- ·Most interviews continue to be via video calls; &
- ·Hybrid working seems to be accepted by most companies, with at least 1 day working from home accepted by most companies.

Demand for Planners & Project Controllers is still 90-95% for permanent/ staff, but demand for freelance/ contract assignments is slowly increasing. I had hoped that with the UK mini budget that we'd see contract work increasing in 2023 as IR35 regulations were loosened, but with the turmoil in the UK government, our hopes were raised then crushed again all in a matter of weeks as IR35 regulations will now remain as is. Who knows what the future will bring from whoever is in charge of UK government.

Contract jobs are still predominantly being

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deemed by the employer to be inside IR35, but many companies are not conducting a CEST assessment at all, it's more a case of their policy being that all contracts will be deemed inside IR35 regardless. Very frustrating.

The demand for Planners & Project Controllers to be based full-time on projects in mainland Europe continues to grow as I continue to expand my client base. Having an EU passport or valid visa for the country is key due to Brexit, but I have had several companies in the last quarter stating they will take UK passport holders, which I did not have the previous quarters before, so I sense an easing, as companies continue to add to their teams, & maybe gaining visas in Europe is getting quicker/ easier.

There is still lots of demand & interest from employers seeking Planners that have a site management, site engineer or civil engineer background prior to moving into Planning, but this is not essential.

I am looking forward to a continued busy 2022 & then 2023 will soon be here. May 2023 be great for us all. At the time of writing, I have 30+ high quality jobs (you can see those jobs here:

https://bit.ly/2LM4yZr, & I try to update the jobs lists I produce every fortnight (as time allows). The jobs that I work to fill are spread geographically in the UK & all over Europe. 
